Parish Council News

Posts and rails around Village Green

There are still some posts and rails to be repaired down Main Street. In addition a contractor has been asked to supply a quote to extend the posts and rails around the Village Green.

Relocation of Mono-Pole from Dasket Hill

In support of the application to test the level of emissions Ofcom require monitoring to be carried on at least six sites within the Village. The Parish Council has nominated eight sites at The Croft, the end of Old Mill View, Laurels Garth, the Post Office, the Primary School, the Play Area at the Village Hall, Coble Lane and the corner of Cornborough Road at the junction with the roundabout. The Parish Council will publish the results in the Village News. There have been no reports of improved reception through the Mono-Pole since transmission began.

Litter Bins:

Four litter bins around the Village will be replaced by the Parish Council. These are in West End, Main Street, East End and near the seat outside York Wines.

Children's Fair:

The children's Fair on the Village Green will take place between 24th and 26th July.

Village of the Year Competition

A sincere thanks you to all of you who have helped us in any way during this school year. We really do appreciate your contributions to our school. Many of our community volunteers have supported us in various events, school trips and special projects (such as the World War II project in class 3), and others in weekly activities such as gardening club, helping with music in school, listening to readers, to name but a few. Your knowledge and experience really do enrich the learning process for our children (and staff).

Our governing body is made up of representatives from school staff, parents, community members and appointments by the Local Authority. The governing body has a largely strategic role, helping shape the vision and direction of the school. The contribution from our community governors is important, largely because they bring us wider experiences and an objective view of our school. We retain a list of potential community governors for when these vacancies arise. If you feel you would like to give your time and skills to the school in this capacity, please let us know.

We are involved in a very exiting 2-year project at the moment. Named the "Comenius Project", a group of 4 European schools (UK, Sweden, Spain and Turkey) are making links with each other.
