## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS OF A CASA VOLUNTEER:

- 1. Must be twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 2. Must successfully pass screening requirements which include a written application, criminal record and Child Abuse Registry checks, personal interview, and three personal references.
- 3. Must successfully complete initial thirty (30) hours of training provided by the CASA volunteer Program Director. Any sessions missed must be made up by the applicant before being appointed to a case.
- 4. Must be accepted as a volunteer by the CASA volunteer Program Coordinator and sworn in by the Judge.
- 5. Must participate in ongoing training, a minimum of twelve (12) hours annually.
- 6. Must accept supervision and seek feedback from the Director on a regular basis.
- 7. Must be able to keep information confidential and to work within established CASA volunteer policy and procedure guidelines.
