

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS OF A CASA VOLUNTEER:

1. Must be twenty-one (21) years of age.
2. Must successfully pass screening requirements which include a written application, criminal record and Child Abuse Registry checks, personal interview, and three personal references.
3. Must successfully complete initial thirty (30) hours of training provided by the CASA volunteer Program Director. Any sessions missed must be made up by the applicant before being appointed to a case.
4. Must be accepted as a volunteer by the CASA volunteer Program Coordinator and sworn in by the Judge.
5. Must participate in ongoing training, a minimum of twelve (12) hours annually.
6. Must accept supervision and seek feedback from the Director on a regular basis.
7. Must be able to keep information confidential and to work within established CASA volunteer policy and procedure guidelines.
