

VOLUNTEER SCREENING:

All volunteers will be screened for acceptance and assignment to the CASA volunteer program through an application and initial face to face interview process prior to commencement of basic training.

The volunteer will fill out a complete application form and submit names for three (3) references. There will also be a criminal record and background check that consist of, but not limited to, a CPS check, and NCIC criminal history checks and BMV check. The proper information and proper permission must be obtained for the check to be done.

The Warrick County CASA Program makes every effort to cooperate with other agencies to improve services for individual children and their families.

The Program Director will be responsible for conducting the screening and interview. The screening interview will be designed to gather information about the prospective volunteer. All information is then given to the Warrick Circuit Court Judge for approval.
