- Are you willing to learn, evolve and expand in all dimensions of education?



### Be a presentable professional...

- You are a role model!
- Dress code aviod provocative, revealing fashions.
- How do you handle and communicate with all the different role players?
- Cellphone use / smoke-breaks during work hours.
- · Social behaviour during and after hours.
- · Social media accounts
  - You are an employee of the school, and therefore accountable.
  - WhatsApp groups... be careful... Admin authority.



# Relationships – challenges / traps

- Learners You are not a friend, you're a role model!

  - Behave like one.
  - Be polite & respectful

- Principal / Employer You are an employee under contract.
  - You are being paid to fulfil a certain job-description.

### Extra-curricular duties

- Why are our schools run this specific way?
  - Academics; sports; culture & social activities: to address conflict, teamwork, bullies, success, failures, disappointments, achievements.
  - Functional educational systems are furnished with many small events, that imitate real life to equip our learners with skillsets to master any challenge.
- Young energetic students / educators = Operate 24/7
  - · First to arrive last to leave.
  - At midnight, after the bus returned from an athletics meeting, wait for the last parent to come and fetch their child.
