





### INTRODUCING THE BOROUGH

The London Borough of Bromley covers over 60 square miles, making it the largest of all the London Boroughs. It is urbanised to the north and west, while in the south-east there are acres of rich farmland, wooded hills and picturesque villages.

Created in 1965, the Borough takes in Bromley, Orpington, Beckenham, Penge, Chislehurst and Biggin Hill, serving a total population of about 300.000.




An emergency duty officer – the council is always on standby for local emergencies

Main rail networks provide the Borough with a frequent train service.

# DEVELOPING FOR THE FUTURE

Already a thriving centre for commerce and recreation, the Borough still has more to offer in the shape of Bromley's Glades development. Principally a shopping centre, this new complex, due to open in Autumn 1991, also includes The Pavilion, Bromley's new leisure centre.

The completion of Bromley's Town Centre relief road will be good news for motorists and pedestrians alike. The new road, due to open in 1993, will leave the High Street free for complete pedestrianisation, and in so doing, promote the safety of shoppers and reduce traffic congestion.

The construction of the massive 220,000 sq ft Crystal Palace Park development is scheduled to commence in 1991. The development, comprising a hotel and leisure centre, will complement other superb leisure and sports facilities in the Borough.

Biggin Hill airport is a thriving centre for business traffic. The airport also accommodates eight private flying clubs.



Bromley currently manages 12,500 council houses although discussions are in hand (May 1991) with a proposed new housing association (Broomleigh) about a transfer of that responsibility to them. The decision on such an arrangement will be made only after tenants have had a chance to consider this situation and vote.
