Participation in Cowboy Cadillac helps to restore sight through the Oklahoma Lions Eye Bank as well as providing a home and family environment for abused & neglected children through the "Meadows of Hope."

**Wilmes Ford in Altus, Oklahoma will be** our **Grand Prize Sponsor!** The drawing will be held on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 1:00 PM on the showroom floor located at 108 North Veterans Drive, Altus, OK 73521.

Lions who sell \$30 worth will also receive a 2016 Cowboy Cadillac award pin.

Tickets are \$5.00 each and only 25 thousand will be sold! That gives each ticket holder at least a one in 25K chance of winning! You can sell tickets for this special event every chance you get such as at: Community events, County Fairs, concession stands, ball games, dinners, chili cook-offs, pancake breakfasts, local festivals, etc.

Let's challenge ourselves to achieve more than we ever have before. Let's BELIEVE BIG but <u>remember</u> this special event's purpose is to bring awareness to the work Oklahoma State Lions Projects are doing. - All individual sales will go toward a *Louis Lackey Fellowship* (\$250) or *Dr. Bob McCullough Fellowship* (\$500), and the *Judge Edgar Vaught* (\$1000) *Awards*. These will be awarded at the end of the fiscal year based on a combination of individual contributions, Cowboy Cadillac ticket sales, and Building the Foundation contributions.
- 2016 LIONS Cowboy Cadillac Pin (new design) to each Lion with a minimum of \$30 in ticket sales.

Important!!!! We ask you to enter start and end numbers for tickets sold within your club. Please use the provided spreadsheets. These include the information we need to properly track sales, and will help us to ensure proper credit for the participants. Please try to mail your ticket stubs and money to include a Club Report Roster (who & how many). This information helps us track individual sales for individual awards. Stubs without money or money without stubs leads to confusion in record keeping and may lead to award distribution errors.

Because we have a **limited number of tickets** this year, we will not be able to send out additional tickets to clubs who have already been issued tickets until monies have been returned for the previous tickets issued. This is to be fair to all participating clubs!
