

## EASTSIDE EASY RIDER COLLABORATIVE (EERC) 2020 WORK PLAN

### EERC 2020 WORK PLAN PROJECTS

1. **Facilitate the Eastside Advocacy for Transportation Services (EATS) Workgroup.** Develop, coordinate, and implement a strategy for transportation services for special needs populations in East King County, namely Bellevue, Kirkland, and Redmond. Host workgroup meetings to identify long-term and short-term solutions to launch a pilot program for either the expansion of new services or modification of existing services.
2. **Organize Two Mobility Coffee Talks.** Following the success of previous events, continue to organize local, informal gatherings on mobility and transportation for both transportation providers and riders. Reflect on identified transportation gaps and provide an opportunity to discuss creative approaches to overcome them. Share resources and foster collaboration among community members.
3. **Coordinate Two Transportation Resource Fairs.** Promote transportation education through coordinated outreach events on the Eastside. Complete two Transportation Resource Fairs in coordination with local community partners, coalition stakeholders, and other transportation service providers to educate residents on transportation options within East King County.

### EERC VISION & MISSION STATEMENT

**Vision:** A coordinated transportation network that allows all people to move freely around East King County and throughout the Puget Sound region.

**Mission Statement:** As the regional mobility coalition in East King County, the Eastside Easy Rider Collaborative (EERC) works to improve regional mobility awareness and access to transportation for special needs populations in East King County through education, advocacy, coordination, and collaboration. The EERC focuses its efforts on older adults, people with disabilities, low-income households, people experiencing homelessness, refugees, recent immigrants, limited-English proficient populations, youth, and other populations that are disproportionately affected by limited transportation options.

### EERC 2020 GOALS

- Goal 1** Maintain and expand active participation of Eastside Easy Rider Collaborative members.
- Goal 2** Partner with member organizations to bring mobility improvement projects to East King County.
- Goal 3** Partner with member organizations to bring policy ideas to decision makers at municipal levels.
