2018 INCLUSIVE PLANNING PROCESS

The King County Mobility Coalition (KCMC) recently took part in Round 1 of the Inclusive Planning Grant. The project encourages the use of inclusive planning processes by including **YOU**, the user, in the discussion and development of programs designed to fit **YOUR** needs. We are focused on improving transportation for *all* King County community members, with focus on older adults, people with disabilities, and their caregivers, including non-English speakers, low-income individuals, people experiencing homelessness, immigrants, refugees, Veterans, and youth. The KCMC was awarded Round 2 funding to continue this work throughout 2019.





ROUND 1 SUCCESSES

- ⇒ **Community Outreach:** We conducted a Transportation Survey, held two Mobility For All Summits, and four Listening Sessions. We received feedback from over 500 community members and partners!
- ⇒ Action Plan: We used the information we received from you the community to create an Action Plan to improve five areas of transportation: trip planning, cultural competency (inclusiveness), marketing and information sharing, payment, and the built environment (infrastructure).
- ⇒ **Round 2 Funding:** While the Action Plan from Round 1 is guiding our plans for Round 2, we want to continue gathering input from the community every step of the way. Learn how you can get involved on the back of this page!











ROUND 2 TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

- ⇒ **Community Transportation Navigators:** Community members will be trained on alternative modes of transportation. These Community Navigators can then train other members of their community that may be looking for transportation information. The scope, curriculum, and compensation plan will be developed.
- ⇒ One-Call/One-Click: A coordinated system that would simplify and improve the user experience of finding and securing transportation in the region. This platform would provide users with one phone number or website to both *find* and *request* rides.
- ⇒ **Transportation Marketing Plan:** Help to improve the process by which local transportation agencies communicate with their customers and share service updates.
- ⇒ Inclusive Planning Toolkit: The creation of a resource that can be used as a reference guide for improving the inclusiveness of KCMC and our partners. We are hoping to become a leader in inclusive processes in our region.
