NKCMC VISION & MISSION STATEMENT

Vision: A transportation network that allows all people to move freely around North King County and the surrounding region.

Mission Statement: As the regional mobility coalition in North King County, the North King County Mobility Coalition (NKCMC) works to facilitate mobility improvement projects for special needs populations in North King County, improve education and awareness of transportation needs, and coordinates with members and service providers to identify transportation challenges. The NKCMC focuses its efforts on older adults, people with disabilities, low-income households, people experiencing homelessness, refugees, recent immigrants, limited-English proficient (LEP) populations, youth, and other populations that are disproportionately affected by limited transportation options.



NKCMC 2021 PRIORITIES

- Priority 1** Strengthen relationships with city representatives from North King County.
- Priority 2** Expand education and outreach to populations identified as previously underserved by the NKCMC.
- Priority 3** Maintain and expand active participation of North King County Mobility Coalition Partners.

2021 WORK PLAN PROJECTS

| 1. Connect with Local Cities on Upcoming Projects. Work with coalition members and partners at the city level to identify transportation projects undergoing review in 2021, and provide meaningful feedback on said projects. The coalition will start by focusing on the City of Shoreline's Transportation Master Plan update. | January-December |
| 2. Coordinate Two Transportation Resource Events with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Populations. Work with Mobility Education & Outreach (MEO) to identify organizations that work directly with LEP individuals and target efforts towards understanding their educational needs and meeting those needs with resources provided by coalition members. | February-June |
| 3. Engage with Community Members about the Walking Environment in North King County. Coordinate a community-based walking group or taskforce to help enable residents to explore walking routes and discuss challenges in their neighborhood. This may include walks to a nearby bus stop or other key destinations. Design fact sheets about how to engage with elected officials to improve walking environments in various neighborhood. | July-September |
