- Responded to COVID-19: 1) Impact Summaries, 2) partner meetings at the individual county level, and 3) Resiliency Roundtable event
- Hosted 6 workgroup meetings (5 virtual) with an average attendance of 23 participants (compared to 16 in 2019)
