2020 Achievements

- Finalized and printed the 5 Year Transportation Plan! Hosted a celebration meeting and got started on our Priority of Projects.
- Strengthened membership by reaching 104 coalition partners! We added 28 new partners in 2020, 11 of which became active coalition members. *An active coalition member is an individual who has attended at least two meetings in one calendar year.*
- Increased the average attendance at our general meetings from 18 to 22.
- Maintained the Task Force who has done remarkable work at the city level to build on supporting public transportation in city Comprehensive Plans.
- Initiated the Project List for the 5 Year Plan to strengthen regional collaboration between Monroe, Duvall, Carnation, Fall City, Preston, Snoqualmie, North Bend.
- Participated in 4 presentations advocating for safe, dependable, convenient, affordable and accessible transportation at the City of North Bend, City of Duvall, City of Carnation and Duvall Rotary.
- Gained momentum in stakeholder groups including the Snoqualmie Valley Community Network's Healthy Community Coalition, Snoqualmie Valley Governance Association, Eastside Transportation Partnership and King County Mobility Coalition.
- Snoqualmie Valley Transportation Coalition was chosen as 1 of 10 new coalitions for a Federal Transit Administration report to Congress on coalition building, coordination and engagement success.
