SKCMC 2020 WORK PLAN PROJECTS

The SKCMC is required to have at least 2 Work Plan projects per work year. Below are listed the Work Plan projects the SKCMC intends to focus its efforts on for the upcoming year. Item numbers 1 and 2 are the primary Work Plan projects for 2020. All additional items beyond numbers 1 and 2 are to be considered supplemental. These are projects that the Coalition intends to focus efforts on with additional bandwidth as resources and availability allow. The Coalition may reprioritize this list at any time during their work year.

Primary Work Plan Projects:

- 1. Partner on the Care Mobility Rewards Program.** Assist in the limited launch of the program to reduce hospital readmissions for Medicare recipients in South King County. Identify sustainable funding opportunities to launch a pilot in at least one medical facility in South King County.
- 2. Increase coordination of South King County transportation providers.** Organize a Roundtable Discussion for South King County transportation providers to increase coordination of South King County transportation providers and establish regular communication channels and resource sharing.
- 3. Increase transportation education to harder to reach populations in South King County.** Increase transportation education and organize travel trainings for harder to reach populations, including isolated community members and multi-family housing residents. Lead awareness campaigns of transportation services that are culturally competent and utilize new methods such as transcreation and pictograms for limited English proficiency populations.

Additional Work Plan Items for Inclusion (As Time and Resources Allow):

- 4. Increase Access to Reduced ORCA options.** In partnership with Metro, Neighborhood Pop-Ups (previously ORCA To-Go), and Public Health, increase access to reduced ORCA options and educate South King County residents on reduced ORCA options.
- 5. Organize Listening Sessions with Community Members.** Organize city-specific listening sessions with community members to understand “First Mile/Last Mile” needs and share findings with decision-makers.
- 6. Create a Small Business Employer Toolkit.** In partnership with the KCMC Access to Work and School Committee, develop and pilot an employer-focused transportation options toolkit for small employers.
