TAC's building was no longer available to them due to COVID-19. Before COVID-19, TAC
considered virtual shows. COVID-19 motivated them to make this happen. Hosting shows
online has brought new members to their organization. Until last year, they were a gallery
focused club. There is now a physical gallery and a virtual gallery so they have to rethink how
they manage both. Renovation of the gallery is now in process.

National shows are harder to get work accepted because of the high volume of entries. Regional shows have a better chance of getting in the show. The challenge is getting the art buyers to their online shows. Crosby Festival is a good example to look at for large online exhibitions. Universities are also moving to virtual shows.

Shows need to have diverse bodies of work so that shows do not become stale.
