Terms and Conditions

1. Any person who produces waste is bound by a duty of care (Environmental Protection Act 1990) ... to prevent the escape of waste. Accordingly, skips must not be loaded higher than the sides of the skip. It is illegal to transport overloaded skips.

2. The Environmental Act 1990 also requires that a description of the waste to be placed in the skip be given at the time of booking.

3. The following materials MUST NOT be placed in skips without prior written agreement::

- i. Asbestos material of any kind.
- ii. Substances hazardous to health such as toxic or corrosive metals or liquids.
- iii. Liquid waste of any kind, whether contained or not.
- iv. Cans, drums or other containers, unless empty and crushed.
- v. Medical waste or animal carcasses.
- vi. Any other material not listed above, however considered unsuitable for containment in a skip.

4. The hirer accepts full responsibility for the safe storage/use and for any loss or damage caused to the skip during the hire period. This includes loss or damage caused by third parties.

5. The Highways Act 1980 requires that permission be obtained from the relevant highways authority before any skip is placed on the public highway.

6. The Highways Act 1980 requires that all skips on the public highway be properly coned and lit during the hours of darkness. It is the hirer's responsibility to provide lights and cones. The hirer accepts liability for any charges or penalties liable for inadequate cones or lights.

7. The hirer accepts full liability for damage caused to private property during the delivery or collection of skips.

8. Our payment terms are strictly 30 days from end of month.

9. In the event of unpaid accounts, all services will be suspended immediately and all outstanding monies will become due.
