

ED Report Updates through 5/18/17

- Executed paperwork to formalize a relationship with Affinity Federal Credit Union. Becoming a partner means that we share their information with board, staff, and advocates and they in turn will allow us to be eligible for Jeans' Day partnerships and to share information with their staff.
- Invited to appear on Hunterdon radio show geared towards 55+ retirees in July – focus will be on volunteer recruitment in Warren County.
- Sent a request to the NJ Beard and Mustache Club to talk about possible partnership for Mother's Day in 2018 where members would deliver Mother's Day flowers in tutus/leggings with proceeds going to CASA. My brother is a member of a Portland Beard Club, and they do this for breast cancer prevention. Very successful for them, nothing like it here.
- The PeopleCare Center's Board has approved a 3-year lease with the rent locked in at \$270/month; we have been doing a year-to-year lease for the past three years.
- Addressed Alice's walk with state ED's network. All expressed admiration for the effort, many want to partner next year to do it as a one-day event statewide. Waiting for us to start with a planning committee.
- The interns have completed their service for this semester.
- Met with members of the Warren County Educational Partnership, re: bringing Trauma Informed Care to Warren County teachers. The county Department of Education has agreed to let us show "Paper Tigers" as part of their county-wide inservice day October 9th; will have a follow-up training a few weeks later.
- Karen and Lynn both attended the state's "Summit" that was put together by the new ED; they said it was a rocky start but they ended up learning some new things.
- Picked up "Sweet Bags" from a donor in Flemington via "Together We Rise."
- Cancelled scheduled PC meeting; several people had last minute conflicts. Will reschedule.
