The **High School Summer School** lottery registration process is complete, and families have been notified and sent an email with the information to pay for classes. If your child did get a class through the lottery, and you did not receive an email from us, please contact us at summerschool@oakparkeducationfoundation.org.

The deadline to pay for classes received through the lottery is **May 5**. If you have not paid for your class by the deadline, your child will be removed to make room for other students. Shortly after that date, for any classes with additional space, you will be able to sign-up directly through the summer school website.
