About the Tangentyere Integrated Support Program

The Tangentyere Integrated Support Program (ISP) is a unique support service for Aboriginal people living in Alice Springs who are affected by alcohol.

We are a team of Case Workers and Community Workers who provide client-led outreach support to reduce harms associated with alcohol.

What we can do

- Talk to you about your worries;
- Come to where you are staying;
- Help you see other services like housing;
- Help you with other problems or things that are causing stress;
- · Work with men and women; and
- Get people get home, or back out bush.

What we offer

- Emotional support;
- Support and advocacy in accessing other services;
- Assistance for visitors to return to country;
- Support of community-led initiatives;
- Community-led initiatives to reduce the harmful effects of alcohol:
- Alcohol education and support; and
- Support with visitor management related issues.
