- 1. Start your holiday by protecting your luggage.**
Before you pack for your holiday, treat your luggage with **Rug Remedy BED BUG KILLER** - follow the instructions on the bottle. When you arrive at your hotel, use luggage stands or wardrobes to store them while you're away. Keep them away from beds!
- 2. Bed Inspection time!**

- 3. Hiding places.**
The little critters love a dark corner, so check the room as well. Under furniture - chairs, sofas etc.

Avoid putting dirty clothes in a pile on the floor - Bed Bugs love to snuggle up in anything with lots of creases and folds. Don't provide a Bed Bug love nest.
- 5. Don't Panic!**
If you do happen to find evidence of Bed Bugs when you first arrive in your hotel room, head straight to the reception desk and request a new room in another part of the hotel - not the next door room. Or get in touch with your holiday rep and see if they can book you into another hotel.
- 6. Before you leave.**
It's always a sad day when you need to start packing to return home, but don't make it worse by bringing home any hitch-hiking Bed Bugs. Spray your luggage again with **Rug Remedy BED BUG KILLER** before you start packing - allow to dry before you put your clothes in.
