

Remember, three main factors when choosing a guide construction are:


- 1. Wall construction

Z GUIDE

Typically used with masonry wall construction


4 ANGLE

Most common for doors with chain/crank/motor operation




2 ANGLE

Typically used for small push-up doors that can utilize an inside adjustor



2 ANGLE - TUBES

Typically used if there's no wall support, and tubes and guides need to be recessed within the wall construction
