### Information on Current Restrictions for Members

# What do the Restrictions mean for Players?

### Who can play?

- 1. Full games of Squash / Racketball may only be played between members of the same household, Social Support Bubble or Squash/RB Bubble (max 6 people)
- 2. Other players must play 'Sides' (ask us or see ESR website for details). The same player must serve throughout the game
- 3. No more than 2 players on court at any one time

#### **Booking Courts**

- 1. Court bookings will be via our new online system or by telephone (still requires account set up online). If you are not yet set up please speak to Adam.
- 2. Court bookings will be 1hour, with the first 40mins playable. The other 20mins are required for cleaning and air circulation
- 3. Equipment may be hired; please return it promptly to the bar so it can be cleaned
- 4. Due to cleaning guidance, only booked courts may be used; i.e. children and guests will not be able to use a free court for play
- 5. The glassback court will remain out of use until further notice due to air circulation issues.


# **Using the Club**

1. On arrival players must register at the allocated section of bar, signing to accept the current terms of use. The option to opt out of Track & Trace will be offered.

- 2. Changing rooms & showers are currently at limited capacity. Players are encouraged to arrive in kit and return home to shower wherever possible. Where the changing rooms are used, these are limited to two people showering at a time, with an additional 2 spaces available for changing. No personal belongings may be left in the changing rooms at any time.
- 3. Showers & changing rooms will be cleaned every hour by a member of staff, which may mean temporary closure. Sprays will be available for members to clean showers down before and after use if they so wish.
- 4. Players are responsible for ensuring their kit is in clean, hygienic condition for each game. ESR recommends a new ball be used for each game.
- 5. During games players are asked to avoid touching the walls as far as possible
- 6. Players are asked not to shake hands after games
- 7. After playing, we ask players not to remain in the indoor club in kit. Players may purchase a drink to take to the outdoor area.
- 8. The water machine is currently not in use; please bring your own filled water bottle. Refills will be available from the bar
- 9. In order to leave corridors clear for members & staff, spectating will not be permitted in these areas. Guests (including children) will be required to wait at a table.

### **Ladders, Club Sessions & Coaching**

- 1. Ladders will restart on 1<sup>st</sup> September with the 'Sides' rules in place except where both players are same household / bubble
- 2. Club sessions will not operate until further notice
- 3. Coaching sessions can be booked for daytime or evening. As there are no 'coaching slots' at present, please arrange directly with your coach and ensure the court is booked



### What do the Restrictions mean for Social Use of the Club?

#### The D&E Bar & Kitchen

- 1. Service will be offered from the designated area of the bar only. Table service will be offered where possible
- 2. On first visit to the bar (per day), members will be asked to sign to accept the current terms of use. The option to opt out of Track and Trace will be given. Guests may be asked to leave a name & telephone number unless opting out.
- 3. Furniture has been arranged to allow social distancing both in and outdoors. Drinking at the bar is not permitted
- 4. The kitchen will remain closed at present.

## **Guidelines Applying to All Users**

- 1. All members & guests are asked to follow the social distancing guidelines and directions in place within the club environment
- 2. To allow everyone to move safely around the club, please ensure children remain at your table unless playing outside in a safe, supervised area
- 3. Contactless or tab payment is encouraged wherever possible
- 4. Please use hand sanitisers and cleaning materials provided
- 5. The dartboard may be used for singles matches only. Players must have their own darts and children may only play with an adult
- 6. All visitors are asked to bring their own basic First Aid supplies. In the event of injury we ask you administer assistance to yourself or members of your household / bubble where possible. First Aiders will help where required, however in the event of CPR being required Rescue Breaths will not be administered as part of this
