DIVE SITES

Dive sites in Forster can be a short 15 min boat ride to Hayden's Rock. With a max. depth of 8m, Grey Nurse Sharks aggregate here around Dec - May. Further out to The Pinnacle at about a 30 minute boat ride, you will find bigger pelagic species, big schools of king fish and resident Rays. Max depth of 33m. And there are so many dive sites in between!

BEST TIME OF YEAR

Grey Nurse Sharks in our area are here all year 'round. But to see them in bigger numbers and better water clarity, aim between December - August



Seal Rocks is a great destination for diving, and while we try our best to get down there sometimes the weather just doesn't want to play nice for us. Sometimes the conditions and forecast are better for diving out of Forster than at Seal Rocks, and we may change our planned destination if this is the case. We cannot take bookings specifically for Seal Rocks because of this weather dependency.

GETTING THERE

Seal Rocks is a 40 min scenic drive from Forster. If wanting to dive here, you will need to drive your car to Boat Beach at Seal Rocks.

Our boat will pick you up at approximately 8:45am and you will need to swim about 50m off the beach. It is then at short 10 min boat ride to the majority of our sites at Seal Rocks.
