Access to the Virtual Conference

Access to the 2020 Esri User Conference (Esri UC) opens on Monday, July 13, at 12:00 a.m. (PDT). You will see a countdown until the first livestream kicks off at 9:45 a.m. (PDT). We encourage you to log in a few hours ahead of the first livestream to ensure that you have access to the event as soon as it begins.


Designated Representatives

After the other person agrees to the handshake, you can then chat or schedule a meeting.
