Dr. Greg Finlayson has practiced counselling and educational psychology at what was then the Hincks Treatment Centre, EarlsCourt Child and Family Centre, and as Senior Psychologist with the Peel District School Board. Then entering full-time private practice for the next 25 years he assessed and treated children, adolescents and adults, and consulted to various agencies where he trained staff, taught foster parents, and provided feedback to parents based on his assessments of youth referred to these agencies. Now retired after 43 years of practice his activities include Track3 Instructor at Caledon Ski Club.

Jennifer Goldhar is a graduate of Ithaca College in New York State. She completed two majors: Outdoor Adventure Leadership and Recreational Therapy. Both degrees had a heavy focus on research and outcome based programming, learning how to demonstrate the need, importance, and benefits of recreation. She is certified as a Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTRS). Most recently, Jennifer worked at a school in New Hampshire which offers residential services for students with severe, complex, and compounding disabilities. She split her time between developing the after school programs, offering individual recreational therapy services, and providing accessible recreation programs including hiking, biking, and kayaking for children and adults of all abilities. Jennifer is Track3's Adaptive Program Coordinator.
