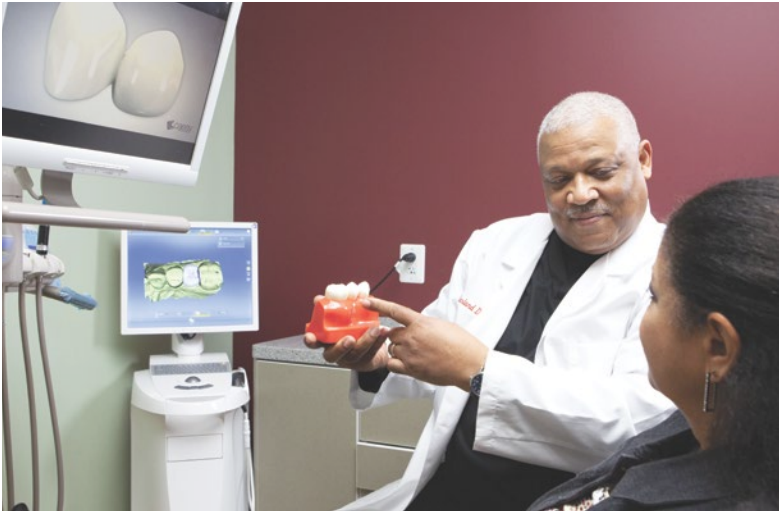

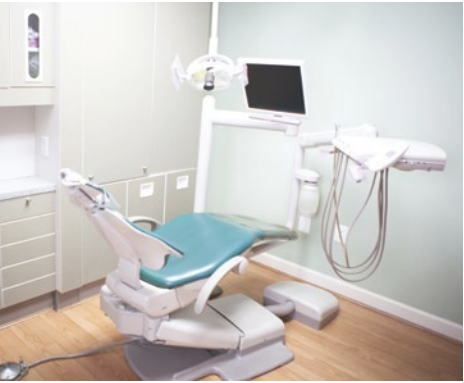

DENTAL IMPLANTS: The Ideal Solution for Missing Teeth



Dr. Davis explains how missing teeth affect the patient's health.

If you're missing one or more teeth, dental implants offer a beautiful, durable and practical solution. "Dental implants look, feel and act more like your natural teeth than any other method of tooth replacement," says Dr. Davis.

How Implants Work

To replace a missing tooth with an implant, a slender titanium post is first placed in the bone of the jaw. This post will act as the root for the replacement tooth. As this area heals, the bone bonds tightly to the post and it becomes a strong and stable support structure. When the implant has healed well, an attachment is fastened to the top of the implant and your clean, white porcelain replacement tooth—called a crown—is secured to the attachment.

"An individual with an implant will be able to eat and talk normally, perhaps for the first time in years," adds Dr. Davis. "Because implants look and feel like natural teeth, they are very popular with my patients."

Patient Comfort Is Vital

Some patients might be concerned about their comfort during this procedure, but Dr. Davis and his staff know how to keep each patient comfortable throughout their treatment. "Patient comfort is very important to us," says Dr. Davis. "We want people to receive the benefits of excellent dental care so we work closely with each patient to find out their concerns so we can reassure

them every step of the way." That caring attitude starts with ensuring that patients understand the steps of their treatment as well as keeping them informed of each new step before it happens.

Precision Implant Placement

A key element in the long-term success of an implant is exact placement in healthy bone. When the implant is placed, a sophisticated, computerized imaging system guides its exact location in healthy bone to ensure its success. If you have lost bone mass, Dr. Davis can first build up the bone with a bone graft before proceeding with an implant. There are many steps to providing a strong, healthy implant, but with Dr. Davis' extensive training and experience, you are in very good hands.

If you're missing several or all of your teeth, dentures are an alternate option to dental implants.

ENJOY THE FREEDOM OF SNAP-ON OVERDENTURES

While dentures restore a person's smile, many patients are looking for a more secure solution. They want to eliminate the unwanted motion of a denture and the need for a sticky adhesive to keep it in place. For these patients, snap-on overdentures are recommended. These are dentures that can be attached to a special kind of dental implant that's been placed in the bone of the jaw. The supporting implants provide stability for the denture, keeping it from moving around, even while talking or chewing.



Eat Your Favorite Foods

Overdenture wearers report that they can eat more types of food and chew more easily when their dentures are anchored on implants. The support of the implants also means that overdentures are less likely to irritate gums or create sore spots.

At the end of the day, the wearer can simply detach the overdenture from the attachments on the top of the implants and clean it normally.

Much More Comfortable than Traditional Dentures

When a patient is wearing a denture on the upper arch, securing it on stable implants means that the entire palate does not need to be covered for the fit to be secure. This is a relief for those patients who find a conventional denture bulky, making it hard to speak clearly.

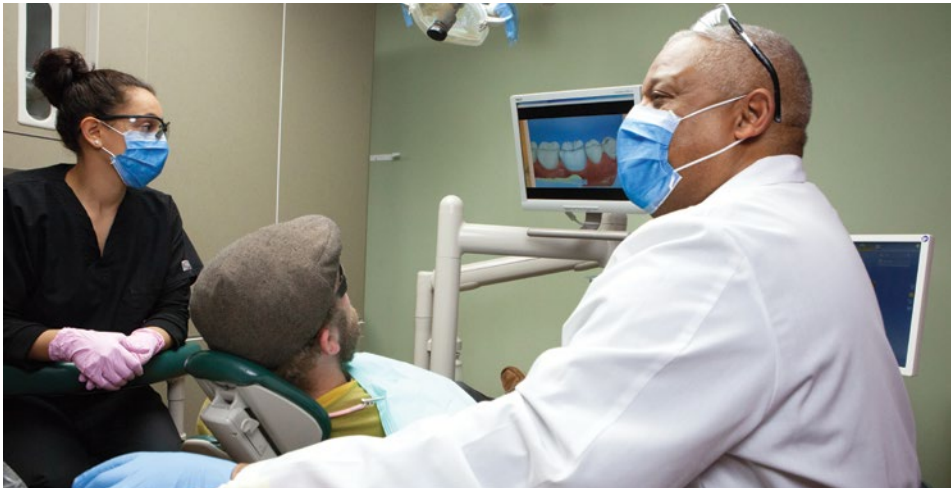

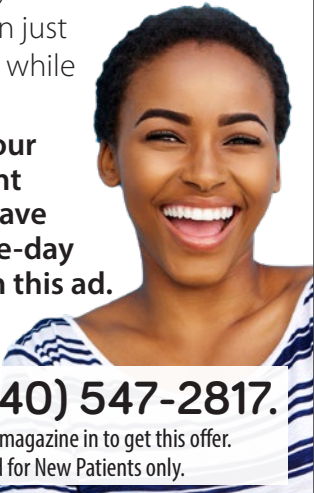

Veneers for a DAZZLING NEW SMILE

For patients who seek cosmetic improvements to their smiles, veneers have so much to offer! In just two weeks for most patients, people who have long been unhappy with severe discoloration, poor spacing or other imperfections can have brand-new, shiny smiles they love to show off.

When We Recommend Veneers



Veneers are thin, ceramic shells that cover the front and the tip of one or more of your teeth. Here are some of the imperfections veneers can improve:

1. Deeply discolored teeth that won't respond to whitening can be brightened with veneers. This includes patients with tetracycline staining.
2. Chipped teeth can quickly be returned to their proper shapes.
3. When there are unattractive gaps between the teeth, veneers can fill these spaces.
4. Teeth that are different lengths or irregularly shaped can be evened out with veneers.
5. Moderately crooked teeth can be straightened with the placement of veneers, a task taking just two weeks, in most cases, instead of several months.

Are You A Candidate For Veneers?

Dr. Davis can offer porcelain veneers or Lumineers, a thinner shell covering the teeth to be treated.

There are advantages unique to each method. Some patients prefer the slightly more natural appearance of the porcelain veneer, but this method will require that a small amount of enamel be removed from the front and tip of the tooth. Numbing will probably be required for this preparation. Lumineers, though, are thinner so only require that the tooth be slightly etched to prepare it for a bond with the veneer. In this case, numbing is not needed.

After a consultation on the enhancement you desire for your smile, Dr. Davis will



advise you on the option that will give you the best result.

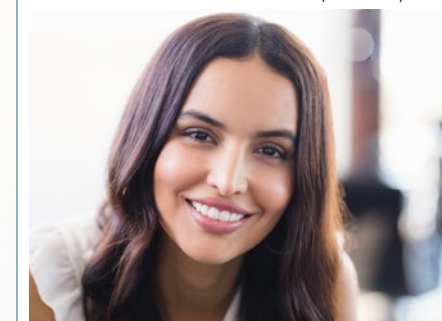

ACHIEVING YOUR COMPLETE SMILE MAKEOVER



For most smile makeovers, Dr. Davis includes treatment with veneers, crowns, dental bonding and teeth whitening.

VENEERS:

Veneers are thin shells which cover the front and tip of each tooth. Dr. Davis uses veneers for teeth that are discolored, chipped, unevenly spaced or irregularly formed.

CROWNS:

Dental crowns are used to strengthen and protect damaged, weakened or structurally unsound teeth.

DENTAL BONDING:

Dental bonding involves using a tooth-colored composite material to repair isolated chipped teeth or cover severe discoloration.

TEETH WHITENING:

Zoom!® teeth whitening creates a change of several shades in a procedure that can be completed over a lunch break.

ZOOM® TEETH WHITENING

When age, foods, drinks or smoking have darkened teeth, Zoom teeth whitening can quickly brighten them with an in-office treatment. This process takes about 60 to 90 minutes total, and involves applying a whitening agent to

your teeth and then shining a laser on them. Yes, your eyes will be protected with special goggles during this process. You should be able to see a difference of two to three shades right away.

It also involves giving the patient a healthy bite.

9. Pain and sensitivity from gum recession or decay

ANXIETY FREE DENTISTRY

We want all our patients to have access to the best dental care so they can maintain optimum dental health. We understand for some people, visiting the dentist is not easy. Part of providing excellent care for our community is making dentistry for anxious patients possible by adding special training and equipment to ensure a relaxing and anxiety-free experience in our office.

The most common anxiety control we use is nitrous oxide. Other forms of anesthetic or sedation usually have a considerable wait time for medications to take effect. The advantage of nitrous oxide is that it takes effect instantly, allowing dental work to commence just minutes after administration. When nitrous oxide is no longer administered, the effects wear off immediately.

We Work with You to Keep You Comfortable

We can tailor the administration of nitrous oxide to achieve the level of anesthesia or sedation you need to make you comfortable during your treatment. For

this, we need to hear from you. Before coming for treatment, please tell us about your needs. We understand that it may not be comfortable explaining your anxieties but please be assured, we are only here to help you maintain your health. We have many patients with similar concerns and we have been able to help them over their barriers to getting good dental care.

How Nitrous Oxide is Used

We will fit a breathing mask over your nose. This mask will stay in place during your treatment. It's important that you avoid talking or breathing through your mouth while the mask is on so please ask all questions before treatment starts.

While nitrous oxide is being administered, you will be able to hear and respond to directions. You may feel light-headed or tingly. Your arms and legs may feel heavy.

When your treatment is complete, you will be given oxygen for a few minutes to help clear away the effects of the nitrous oxide. Then the mask will be removed.

Another advantage of nitrous oxide is it is



not necessary to have someone drive you home. As soon as the effects of nitrous oxide have worn off – usually just a matter of minutes – it is safe to operate a vehicle.

We know that not all patients need sedation before dental care. Our doctors have many years of experience reassuring patients before and during treatment. For some anxious patients, this is all the support they need.

As a new patient if you are anxious about an upcoming procedure, please let us help you understand the process and help you calm your concerns. Call us with any questions you might have before you schedule your next appointment.

Dental emergencies can happen to anyone. When tooth loss, injury or pain strikes, it's important to get immediate care to limit the amount of damage suffered and alleviate discomfort. When you suffer

When an EMERGENCY STRIKES



For any dental emergency, call the office of Dr. Garland Davis immediately for an appointment. Follow these tips on how to handle the emergency until you see us:

Toothache/Broken tooth: Stop any bleeding by applying pressure with gauze or a soft cloth. Place a cold pack against the face. Take an anti-inflammatory pain medication to reduce any swelling that may occur

Lost filling: For sensitivity, cover it with over-the-counter dental cement available at most drug stores.

Lost crown: Apply clove oil to the tooth for sensitivity. If possible, reposition the crown using toothpaste or over-the-counter dental cement, never any other kind of glue.

The best replacement for missing teeth, dental implants consist of a natural-looking white crown securely fixed to a titanium post (implant) placed in the jaw.

Veneers

Veneers rapidly replace a worn or dull smile with a bright one, with the placement of thin shells over the visible surface of the teeth.

Crowns and Bridges

Crowns protect damaged teeth, extending their life while bridges replace a tooth that's been lost.

Partial and Complete Dentures

Both partial dentures or complete dentures can be carefully fit to the shape of one's bone and gums or they can be anchored to dental implants for better security.

Fillings

Digital X-rays



Digital x-rays are a significant advancement over the film x-ray systems of the past. Patients receive a lower dose of radiation and digital x-rays can be accessed easily and stored forever. Images are available almost immediately and are clearer than previous systems could provide. Enlarging and enhancing each image for diagnostic purposes is now immediate.

CT Scan

A special type of x-ray used when regular dental x-rays are not sufficient. This three dimensional (3-D) imaging of your teeth allow our doctors to see the soft tissue, nerve pathways and bone in a single scan. Our CBCT (Cone-Beam Computed Tomography) scan is extremely valuable for the investigation of impacted teeth, orthodontics and implant planning. Three-dimensional imaging can play a significant role in revealing the best location for implant success.

Same Day Crowns



CEREC is a high-tech system that uses digital imaging of your mouth, computer-aided design and a computer-guided

milling machine that precisely shapes your new crown out of a highly durable material. The CEREC system allows Dr. Davis to complete the design of your crown, including choosing the color that matches your other teeth, in just minutes. Typically, the milling process takes less than an hour to produce your crown once the design is complete. When the crown is finished, it is placed in the patient's mouth- all in a few hours visit to the office*, or a fraction of the time it typically takes when sent to a lab. The crowns produced are both strong and an excellent match for your natural teeth.

*Same-day appts can usually be completed in 4 hrs or less.

Implant Navigational System

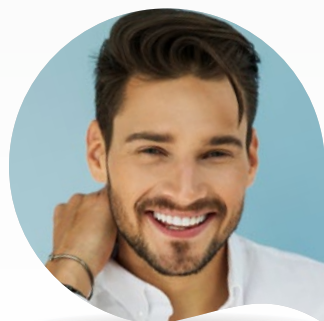
