# LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

Dear Members – As I write this article, we are just embarking on two major construction projects to make improvements to our pool area. The first project has to do with the swimming pool itself. The Eldorado pool has been dealing with a major leak over the last several years. This leak has caused a considerable waste of water and chemicals as it has gotten to the point where we basically need a constant flow of water into the pool to keep the water at a level where the underlying plaster is not damaged. This also makes the pool extremely hard to keep clean or to even find a partner that will work with us on pool maintenance as the pool also requires a constant addition of chemicals to keep up with the new water being continually added to keep the pool full. This work has already begun with the replacement of several key pieces of equipment that keep the pool running properly including sand filters, pumps and chlorinators. Currently, the pool is being drained so that a comprehensive cleaning and electronic leak detection process can be implemented. Once everything is finished, we expect to have a fully functional pool for several years to come without the wastefulness that is the reality with the current situation. We also will be upgrading some of the older equipment at the same time to make sure we are operating as efficiently and as safely as possible for the experience of the Members. This will also include a complete reconstruction of the baby pool which has obviously not had significant work done to it for longer than the main pool. In fact, with the combined systems, there is a good chance that the baby pool is contributing to the current leak rate. We expect this project to be completed by the end of March with plenty of time before the start of the 2017 pool season.

The second project, while also in the pool area, is a direct result of significant damage that was sustained in our Mulligans area during the hard freeze that occurred at the Club just prior to New Year's Eve. Due to the inadequate placement of the water pipes in this area without proper insulation or heat nor the ability to shut the water down to that building, the water pipes burst causing major damage across the entire small kitchen and two bathrooms. To avoid even further water damage to the building, the Club immediately approved the elimination of all water damaged areas including dry walls and ceiling essentially causing the entire building to be stripped down to the studs. Our plan for this reconstruction is twofold. First, we will relocate the pipes into the interior walls of the building (instead of the ceiling or exterior walls) with adequate insulation and exposure to heat. We will also include a shut off valve so that the entire area can be essentially "winterized" during the off season therefore extremely minimizing the chances for future issues. Secondly, we plan to take advantage of the removal of all the walls in that building by reconfiguring the space to improve the overall operational ability for the Club to serve the Members during the summer. While the plans remain tentative at the time of this writing due to continued negotiations with the insurance company, plans include placing the service window to face the pool rather than the corner, add a walk-up window for easier golf course service, keep the current service window but change it into a seated bar, and expand the kitchen by taking some space from the men's bathroom so that the equipment that was housed where the new service window is being installed will have a place to go. It should also be noted that this insurance claim also includes work on the golf course bathroom at the #5 tee box that also sustained water pipe damage during the same hard freeze. This work on the #5 bathroom will commence first since that is an area being currently utilized at the Club while the Mulligans area is not due to reopen until May.

Finally, I would like to remind everyone that per previous correspondence, we will be initiating a 3% dues raise for most Membership categories as of March 1. We are also giving all Members an opportunity to actually receive a significant dues *discount* by referring a new golf Member into the Club. This offer is good until the end of March and includes a discounted dues rate as low as \$260 a month for the remainder of 2017. # NEWS FROM THE COURSE



With Spring just around the corner the course will begin to break dormancy and start getting green. As I write this many of the greens have already begun to do so. The green grass is a welcome sight after looking at dormant turf throughout the winter. This winter has been extremely mild with lots of rain and plenty of nice golfing days and the course has received a lot of play.

We will be extra cautious going forward of any nighttime temperatures forecasted close to freezing in the coming weeks to protect the grass coming out of dormancy. However just because the turf is green does not mean that it is actively growing. In most cases our course does not start actively growing until the night time temperatures start averaging in the mid sixties. So as we begin to transition this month let us keep in mind that the turf albeit green may not be actively growing till mid April.

To handle our turf transition as we come out of the Winter and into the Spring, limiting excess turf traffic during the time period of transition will go a LONG way to improving the overall health of the turf for the entire year. For that reason, we have developed a "fairway closure rotation" to help with the overall long term turf health. Below I have outlined our plan for this procedure during the months of March and April. We feel that this no cost procedure will be extremely helpful in providing you with the best experience possible for the entire year.

- Par 3's on the Course will remain cart path only 100% of the time. These holes include # 5, 7 and 16.
- Several holes have features that should not require any closing (weather permitting) throughout the transition period. These holes include # 1, 2, 6, 10 and 11. We will explore the feasibility of setting up a rotating set of "entrances and exits" on these holes to help prevent wear patterns.
- With the exclusion of the holes above, this means that 10 holes are adversely impacted enough during the transition months due to carts on the fairways that we should implement a rotation system. These holes include # 3, 4, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17 and 18.
- **Proposed Plan:**
  - ◇ Holes 3, 13 and 18 are closed to carts on the fairway from March 6 – March 19.
  - ◇ Holes 4, 9 and 14 are closed to carts on the fairway from March 20 – April 2.
  - ◇ Holes 8, 12 and 15 are closed to carts on the fairway from April 3 – April 16.
  - ◇ Hole 17 is closed to carts on the fairway from April 17 – May 1.
  - ◇ After May 1, all holes (except Par 3's) will be available for cart use on the fairway unless weather or turf condition dictates otherwise.
  - ◇ In 2018, hole rotation will start again in early March with adjustments made given the previous year of experience
- The above dates can be adjusted based on status of our winter to spring transition.
- Hole 17 is scheduled extra by itself as we know that hole is most at risk to accumulate additional damage due to fairway width.




If you haven't noticed already, the courts are filling up fast! Please make court reservations with the shop or you might miss out!
