LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

Dear Members –

Several years ago there was an annual event held at Eldorado Country Club in which two prime parking spaces were auctioned off to the highest bidder. After that event was not renewed, those parking spaces have remained in the “ownership” of the two Members that made the winning bids at the final event despite the fact that the one year commitment has long since passed. In discussing this situation with several tenured Members at the Club, we began to brainstorm about a way to resurrect this former tradition while putting the money raised to good use. With this in mind, I am happy to announce that over the month of April, we will be selling raffle tickets for the opportunity to secure one of two prime parking spaces in the Eldorado Country Club parking lot for an entire year. These raffle tickets will be sold for \$20 apiece. You can purchase as many tickets as you would like between April 1, 2017 and May 1, 2017. On the evening of May 2, 2017 at 7 p.m. in the Sports Grille, we will draw to determine which two people are the lucky winners of these two spots. (You do NOT need to be present to win!) A sign will be made with your name and posted in the parking lot to clearly identify that the parking space is yours and yours alone! Now – this leads to the question: what are we going to do with the money that we have raised from raffling off those two spaces? We have decided that we will take this annual tradition and turn this into a direct benefit for the Members of Eldorado Country Club. Accordingly, we will choose a space around the Club or golf course every year to improve. 100% of the raised funds will be dedicated to the improvement along with additional funds from the Club if needed. For 2017, we have made the decision to upgrade the deck space outside the Tennis Pro Shop. It is obvious that this space has not been maintained to the same level as the rest of the Clubhouse. The fairly recent updates in the Sports Grille patio area is an obvious comparison of a similar type of space that now has more a more relevant and appropriate setting then what currently exists on the Tennis Patio. The extent of what we will be able to do will, from a certain extent, depend on how much money we can raise but initial plans include replacing the furniture, replacing the lighting, adding a wall mounted TV, and changing out the back cabinets to better represent the quality that should be expected at Eldorado Country Club.

NEWS FROM THE COURSE



As we head into April it is a very busy time in the golf course maintenance department. The grass should all have broken dormancy by now and though it may not be growing at full capacities due to soil temperatures being too low, it is still green and much more pleasing to the eye than dormant turf. The soil temperatures should reach optimum between the middle and end of the month. Soil temperature is the main signal that turfgrass uses telling when to grow and when to conserve its energy. For the majority of warm season grasses; which our Bermudagrass falls into, the window between 70 and 90 degrees Fahrenheit provides the best growing conditions. When soil temperatures are above this range the plant will slow its growth and expend energy to protect itself by storing carbohydrates in the roots to use when the soil temperature returns to optimal growing conditions. When temperatures fall below 70 degrees the plant does the same thing until it gets cold enough to go into dormancy. Keep this in mind throughout the month as the grass may be green but may not be growing at full potential.

With the previous conditions in mind we have scheduled our fairway aerification to begin on Monday, April 10. This will be a core aerification and should be completed within the week as weather conditions allow.

Also during the month of April we will begin vertical mowing the greens in conjunction with our weekly topdressings to help control thatch accumulation in the greens. The majority of the time this will take place on Mondays while we are closed. However there will be times that we must do this on other days during the week. These two cultural practices along with core aerification are the best ways to control thatch in our greens. Your understanding is appreciated while we perform these much needed tasks.
