




Angel



This model uses 2 squares of the same size. One should be the colour you wish for the wings and the other skin colour on one side and robe colour on the other.




Guide to Symbols used in these diagrams




Lay square coloured side down.




Lay square colour side up.




Lay "A" proportioned rectangle coloured side down.




Lay "A" proportioned rectangle colour side up.




Make a preliminary base - white side out.




Make a preliminary base - colour side out.




Make a waterbomb base - white side out.




Make a waterbomb base - colour side out.




Make a bird base white side out.




Make a bird base colour side out.




Make a frog base white side out.



Make a frog base colour side out.




Make a fish base white side out.




