

	The following information is necessary for us to determine eligibility. Bring what applies to <i>any</i> member of the household. For information on-line, you may use the township's computer and printer.
	Valid government-issued picture ID for every adult in the household
	Social Security cards, birth certificates, proof of citizenship, proof of legal US residency if born outside of US (visas, I-94's, etc)
	Proof of all income for past 30 days.
	Social Security benefits award letter or other proof of gross & net amt.
	Proof of Child Support (stubs, printout, statement, etc...)
	Current Food Stamp / TANF benefit statement or printout; FSSA case number
	FWHA benefit letter showing amount you pay, and utility allowance
	60-day transaction history for all financial accounts, including checking, savings, and prepaid debit card accounts like the EPPI and Direct Express cards
	Car registration, title or payment book / statement
	Unemployment decision, status of your claim
	Verification of lump sum payments within past 6 months (tax refund, loans, pensions, annuities, IRA disbursements etc.)
	Other Proof of Income or Assets: (pensions, annuities, IRA's, etc.)
	Tax Information: If you filed, copy of tax return; if you did not file, copies of W2's, 1099's, etc. If someone prepared your taxes, bring all information
	Notarized letter(s) from anyone who lent or gave you money, or paid expenses on your behalf. (Agencies/Churches can give a letter). The letter must have exact dates and amounts, plus the full name, address, and contact number of the person(s) who helped.
	Proof of student status for adults, financial aid paperwork if higher education
	Lease agreement / Mortgage Information
	Ledger print out from landlord (i.e. itemized statement of debts/credits)
	Current utility bills (electric, gas, water, cable, phone...) - even if not in household members' names. Bring them all even if not requesting assistance for them.
	Any disconnect notices or eviction letters within past 60 days
	Receipts to show how cash income was spent
	If anyone is pending SSI or SSD, bring verification of application and all documentation regarding decisions and the status of the case
	If anyone is unable to work due to health reasons, bring doctor's statement
	OTHER:
