Guidelines for Daily Communion April 12, 2020 until the Corona Challenge Lifts

- A. Open with prayer over the elements
- 1. Bread
- 2. Juice
- B. Make a declaration of the things you are believing the Lord for as a family feel free to add daily.

- C. Find scriptures as your supporting foundation.
- D. Partake of the elements (see adapted from Joseph Prince, below).
- 1. Receive the Bread for healing, wholeness, restoration for you and your family.
- 2. Receive the juice declaring you and your family are overcomers, you and Your Family are cleansed and covered by the blood of the Lamb.
- E. Close with a powerful prayer.
- F. You can take communion as many times a week as you like; to secure and release your Faith for miracles, signs, and wonders.

"For every time that you eat this bread and you drink this cup, you commemorate the death of Our Lord, until his coming." 1 Corinthians 11:26 Aramaic Bible in Plain English

TO PARTAKE, FIRST, HOLD THE BREAD IN YOUR HAND AND SAY:

Thank You, Father, for the gift of Your Son. By the stripes that fell on His back, my(our) body is healed from the crown of my(our) head to the very soles of my(our) feet. Every cell, every organ, every function of my(our) body is healed, restored, and renewed. In Jesus' name, I (we) believe and I(we) receive. [Eat the bread.]

NEXT, TAKE THE CUP IN YOUR HAND AND SAY:

Lord Jesus, thank You for Your precious blood. Your sin-free, disease-free, poverty-free life is in Your blood. And Your shed blood has removed every sin from my(*our*) life. Through Your blood, I(*we*) am(*are*) forgiven of all my(*our*) sins—past, present and future—and made completely righteous. Today, I(*we*) celebrate and partake of the inheritance of the righteous, which is preservation, healing, wholeness and provision. Thank You Lord Jesus, for loving me(*us*). Amen. [Drink the wine.]

A Communion Prayer

Lord Jesus, I(we) bow before you in humility and ask You to examine my(our) heart(s) today. Show me(us) anything that is not pleasing to You. Reveal any secret pride, any unconfessed sin, any rebellion or unforgiveness that may be hindering my(our) relationship with You. I (we) know that I(we) am (are) Your beloved child(ren), having received You into my(our) heart and life and having accepted Your death as penalty for my(our) sinfulness. The price You paid covered me(us) for all time, and my(our) desire is to live for You.

Prayer After Receiving Communion

Lord Jesus - what a privilege to be able to come before Your throne of grace and partake of the precious sacraments of bread and wine, in remembrance of Your atoning sacrifice on the cross of Calvary.

Thank You for dying for me(us) on the cross and paying the enormous price for my(our) sins, so that I(we) may be forgiven of all my(our) faults and receive Your indwelling life.

May I(we) never forget the enormous price that was paid on my(our) behalf. May I(we) never forget that I(we) have been bought with a price – the precious blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. May I(we)live for Him from this day on, knowing that Your body was broken and Your blood was spilt - for me(us).
