This is Our Faith

Is the Eucharist really the Body and Blood of Christ or is it just a symbol?

The Eucharist is truly the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord, Jesus.

Why did all Christians believe in the <u>real presence</u> for 1500 years as we still believe as Catholics?

- 1. Jesus stated; "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the son of man, and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." (Jn 6:53). In fact Jesus stated repeatedly that whoever would eat His flesh and drink His blood would have eternal life. Jesus saying this numerous times should be enough to believe!
- 2. When His disciples objected saying, "this saying is hard; who can accept it?" Why didn't Jesus say "You misunderstood? I am only speaking symbolically." We know Jesus was not speaking symbolically but literally because He not only let them leave but asked the others if they wanted to leave also. He would never let that happen if it was symbolic!
- 3. Jesus' own apostle, **John**, **who lived with Jesus**, taught Polycarp that the Eucharist was truly the Body and Blood of Jesus. Polycarp then taught Irenaeus true presence. Why would John teach true presence if it was only a symbol?
- 4. Paul tells the Corinthians that what he received from the Lord was the true presence and if they receive the Body and Blood of the Lord in an unworthy manner without discerning will answer to the Lord. Unworthily receiving His body will bring judgment on themselves and this is why many are ill and a considerable number are dying(1 Cor 11:23-30). Why would anyone dye by eating a symbol of Christ's body?

 Makes no sense!
- 5. 1 Cor 10:16 "Eucharist is it not the participation in the body and blood of Christ.
- 6. Early Father's of the church taught the "real Presence" in the Eucharist.
- 7. Many miracles of the Sacred Host bleeding, turning to tissue etc.
