

Students are learning to be “anchored in success every day, with every opportunity”



Students are constantly learning how to become effective readers through their reading strategies. Using various stories, we explore the vocabulary first which helps us to better understand the story, and we then determine which strategies we are using as we go through the story bit by bit. Dissecting the story and using as many of our reading strategies as we can. This in turn helps make the comprehension part easier to do.




American Government & United States Government are breaking down the Pre-Ambles and committing it to memory.

Fine Arts students are diving in with key signatures and scales. They have a good grasp on recognition of major and minor scales, also they can name all spaces and lines in treble and bass clef.



Students are understanding and comparing fractions, meaning of equation, solutions by multiplication or division, multistep solutions and changing fractions to higher terms.



Our elementary kids are learning about plants, time and money, proper use of parts of speech with emphasis on prepositions and possessive pronouns!



In Middle School Science, we are tackling the animal kingdom; students will identify all exoskeleton animals. They will determine which animals are invertebrates and which are vertebrates.

In Physics, we are covering the system of measurement. We will differentiate between the FPS system and the Metric system of science. We are studying the Kelvin scale and how properly use it as it relates to temperature.
