VISION FOR THE FUTURE

Over the past six months we have been working on developing our School Master Plan. This is a document that the architect develops, in consultation with the school, to address the needs of the educational community into the future. As part of this process, staff, school leadership and students, led by Minx Architects, discussed many facets of our school that need to be considered in any plan.

Now that this Master Plan has been developed, St. Peter's School can begin applying for Capital Funding Grants from the Government to renew, build or redevelop various areas of our school. The Catholic Education Office, Melbourne, decides upon which projects will be forwarded to the Government for approval. At this stage, we are seeking to develop a performing arts space at the back of the




