






The shell of an animal people like to eat steamed






The shell of an animal that likes to eat oysters




The egg case of an animal that can sense electricity



The remnants of an animal that has no brain




A seaweed that grows on rocks



An invasive seaweed that looks like fingers








The shell of an animal that looks like a toenail
