ABOUT THE ASSOCIATION

The Iowa Public Transit Association (IPTA) is the leading advocate for public transit in Iowa. We serve as a resource group and forum for the exchange and dissemination of transit-related information.

IPTA's active membership of urban and regional transit operators represents the interests of the public transit systems serving the citizens of the state. 16 regional transit systems serve rural lowa and 19 urban transit systems provide transportation to small and large urban areas.

lowa's public transit systems provide more than 22 million rides each year, serving all 99 counties in lowa.

Presenting public transit as a viable alternative to private automobiles continues to be a challenge. Transit operators are faced with numerous issues as they strive to offer responsive and reliable transportation service. IPTA provides a forum for operators to discuss how public transit can help provide a higher quality of life for lowans by protecting the environment, conserving energy, and providing for the health, safety, and security of its citizens. By sharing knowledge and resources, IPTA can help members obtain the tools they need to promote the benefits of public transportation and the impact it has on economic development.

Led by a seven member elected board, IPTA provides a mechanism for identifying, discussing and resolving key transit issues. Together we have clout. IPTA can present a unified, strong position based on the collective input of all members. IPTA needs your voice and your membership.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

Members of IPTA shall be assessed annual dues, payable for one (1) year, from July 1 through June 30. Annual dues of members are:

1. Dues for Operator members who are direct recipients of STA, will be assessed according to each system's operating expenditures and the number of revenue vehicles in the system's fleet, as reported to, or recognized by, the lowa Department of Transportation at the end of the previous fiscal year. The Operating Budget component will be assessed according to the following table:

TOTAL OPERATING EXPENDITURE RANGES	DUES ASSESSMENT BASED ON EXPENDITURES
\$0 - \$500,00	\$1,000
\$500,001 - \$900,000	\$1,500
\$900,001 - \$2,000,000	\$2,000
\$2,000,001 - \$3,500,00	\$2,500
\$3,500,001 - \$7,500,00	\$3,000
\$7,500,00+	\$5,000

The Fleet Size component will be assessed at thirteen dollars (\$13.00) per revenue vehicle.

- 2. Dues for Operator members who are not direct recipients of STA, sub-recipients of STA, private-for-profit operators and other operators are \$550 per year.
- 3. Dues for Associate members shall include all companies or individuals doing business relative to public transit or all planning and funding agencies not primarily involved in the operation of public transit systems. Dues are \$150 per year.
