

APPOINTMENT of the RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Hamlet \_\_\_\_\_ of Conistone in the Parish of Brimston in the West Riding of the County of York.



WE HEREBY AN AWARD of RENT-CHARGE in lieu of TITHES in the Hamlet \_\_\_\_\_ of Conistone in the Parish of Brimston in the West Riding, of the County of York \_\_\_\_\_ was, on the twenty eighth Day of December \_\_\_\_\_ in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty eight \_\_\_\_\_ confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Award with the Schedule thereto appended, the following is a Copy—

To all men to whom these Presents shall come I John Set Rawlinson of Graythwaite in the County of Lancaster Barrister at Law, send greeting.

Whereas I have been duly appointed and sworn an Assistant Tithe Commissioner according to the provisions of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales and have also been duly appointed as such Assistant Commissioner to ascertain and award the Total sum to be paid by way of Rent Charge instead of the Tithes of the Hamlet of Conistone in the Parish of Brimston and West Riding of the County of York, which Hamlet the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales have by their Order directed to be considered as a Separate District for the Commutation of Tithes.

And whereas I have held divers meetings for that purpose in the said Parish and near to the said District of which due notice was given for the information of the Landowners and Titheowners of the said District.

And whereas I have fully considered all the allegations and proofs tendered to me at the said meetings by all parties interested and have myself made all enquiries concerning the premises which appeared to me necessary.

And whereas I find that the estimated quantity in Statute measure of all the lands of the said District amounts to Five thousand and sixteen acres of which Six acres are cultivated as Arable land. Ten acres are Plantations or Brushwood. Two thousand and six hundred acres are inclosed Meadow.

or Pasture and Two thousand five hundred acres are unenclosed and uncultivated  
Moors

And whereas I find that a moiety  
of Thirty shillings is of right due and payable yearly at Michaelmas in equal  
moieties to the two Rectors for the time being of the said Parish of Burnstall instead  
of the Tithes of Hay arising from or accruing upon all the lands of the said District

And that throughout all the lands of the said Parish  
of Burnstall not otherwise covered or exempted from payment of such Tithes of which  
Parish the said District of Coniston forms part there is an ancient and laudable  
custom that every inhabitant thereof should pay at Easter in every year to such  
Rectors as aforesaid in equal moieties

Two Pence for every Cow kept by him within the  
Tithable places of the said Parish which has had a calf between Easter and Easter  
in that year

And one penny for every Cow kept by him within the  
same which has not had a Calf between Easter and Easter in that year but which has  
given milk during that year or some part thereof instead of the Tithes of the milk of  
such Cows respectively

And that every inhabitant thereof should also pay  
at Easter in every year to such Rectors as aforesaid in equal moieties

One penny for every breed mare kept by him within  
the Tithable places of the said Parish which has had a foal between Easter and  
Easter in that year instead of the Tithes of Foals

And that all the lands of the said District are  
subject to payment of all manner of Tithes in kind except as aforesaid

And whereas I find that the two  
Rectors for the time being of the two moieties of the said Parish of Burnstall are  
entitled in equal shares to all the Tithes of the said District

And whereas I have estimated

the clear annual value of the Tithes of the said District in the manner directed by  
the said Act of Parliament

*New Kneve Ye* that I the said  
John St. Baulston in the exercise of all the powers which are in me as such Assistant  
Commissioner as aforesaid do make this my Award of and concerning the premises,  
that is to say

I award that the annual sum of Eighty two Pounds  
by way of Rent Charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid in equal  
instalments to the Tax Collectors for the time being of the tax mediety of the said Parish of  
Barnston instead of all the Tithes arising or accruing upon or in respect of all the lands  
of the said District

The aforesaid Rent Charge to be in lieu not only of all  
Tithes payable in kind but also in lieu of all impositions compositions real and prescriptive  
and customary payments for Tithes payable in respect of all or any of the lands of  
the said Hamlet of Coniston or the produce thereof
