RCCO #RaceHome Basics

The **#RaceHome** Charity Racing Series is a SimRacing Championship organized by the RCCO E-Sport AG.

Platform: PlayStation 4

Game: Gran Turismo Sport

#RaceHome wants to generate as many donations as possible to be used for charity projects within the motorsport family which is heavily affected by the COVID-19 crisis.

All revenues earned will be donated to freelance people working in the motorsport business who need financial help.

RCCO #RaceHome Basics

Season 1 of **#RaceHome** will run from April 21, 2020 to June 23, 2020 with 10 weekly races taking place.

A total of 15 cars will compete in the championship, 12 of them with permanent drivers: 6 from DTM and 6 from the RCCO E-Sport Series.

3 cars are reserved for guest drivers and one of them for the **#RaceHome** Design Contest.

The races are run and recorded Monday evening at 1830 CEST and streamed the next day (Tuesday) at 2000 CEST.



RCCO #RaceHome Design Contest – Schedule

Together with AUDI AG, #RaceHome will run a weekly Design Contest which will be open during the following periods (every week from Sunday through Saturday):

RCCO #RaceHome Design Contest – Rules

The winner of the weekly **#RaceHome** Design Contest will be decided by the six Audi DTM drivers who will vote the design of the week. The winner of the weekly Design Contest gains a place on the starting grid for the next **#RaceHome** race.

All individual liveries shared on Gran Turismo Sport during the specified periods with the Tag **#RaceHome** qualify for the Design Contest. Following rules have to be followed:

- > Only liveries for the Audi e-tron Vision Gran Turismo are valid
- > Your livery must feature all official partners of **#RaceHome** in the positions as requested on page 8

RCCO #RaceHome Design Contest – Rules

- > Your livery must feature the hashtags **#AudiTogether** and **#StayHome**
- > Your livery must be published on Social Media using the four hashtags **#etron**, **#RaceHome**, **#AudiTogether** and **#StayHome**
- > You are allowed to post multiple liveries

- > The winning livery will be chosen by the six Audi DTM drivers on Sunday morning
- > The winner will be informed via the Playstation Network and Gran Turismo Sport on Sunday
- > After communicating the e-mail address to RCCO, the winner will get all the necessary information about his participation in the race on Monday evening
