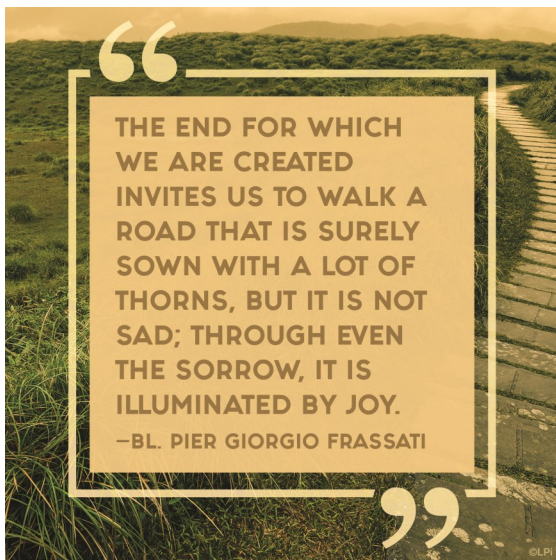

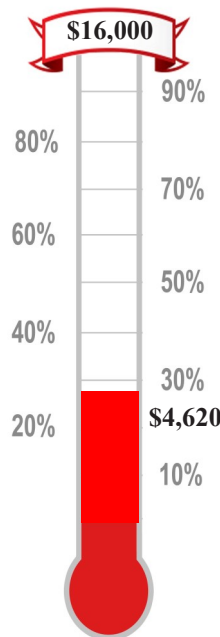
THE LIGHT IS ON

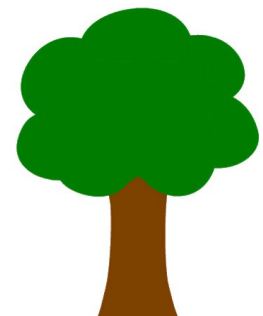
