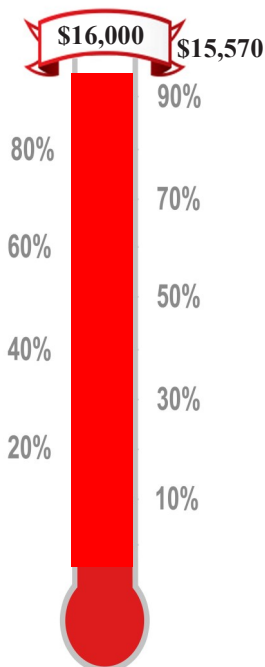

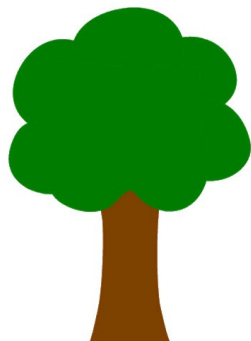

The St. Benedict Project was established for our middle school students just this year, but the impact is already visible. After studying the works of Mercy for several years, middle school students had opportunity to Feed the Hungry as a school community.

Over the course of several weeks, 8th grade teacher Linda Smith took student

volunteers to the Our Lady of Lourdes Hospitality Kitchen, which provides meals to those in need. Students served over 250 individuals each day by preparing food, carrying trays, serving the meal, helping with young children, and spending time with members of our local community.
