#### **Entries**

Entries are via **Queensland Carnival Manager Program**. Nomination closes on Monday, 27 February 2017.

All competitors must be proficient in their appropriate award prior to the close of nominations.

The entry fee is \$16.50 (including GST) per person regardless of no. of events entered. Late nominations will incur a late fee of \$33.00

Branch will invoice the clubs after the Championships.

#### **Clubs outside Wide Bay Capricorn Branch**

Clubs outside Wide Bay Capricorn Branch in Queensland are welcome to enter the competitions (as per Council – Executive meeting of 24.10.09) if they assist with providing judges and officials at the championships.

## **Competitor conditions**

SLSQ High Visibility Clothing Policy, No 95.07.12, will be implemented requiring all competitors in ocean or open water-based surf lifesaving events held in Queensland to wear a high visibility lycra/rash top/singlet.

## **Marine Stinger Protective Clothing**

In accordance with SLSQ Marine Stinger Risk Management Guidelines, and Lifesaving policy LS13, wearing of appropriate and approved Marine Stinger PPE is <u>optional</u> from March for all competitors U11s- U14s, but we will keep monitor the condition leading up to the carnival and will advise if condition changed.

However all competitors are advised to ensure that they have 'Stinger Suit' available to wear for all water events on the day as a precaution. A decision will be made by Carnival Referee in this regard.
