A \$2 parking fee per car (for the general public) will be charged on weekends from April through October when entering Mohawk Park. Members of Oxley get in free. The west gate will be closed on weekends April-October.

OXLEY AND REDBUD HOURS:

The gates at Oxley Nature Center are open daily, with the exception of most City holidays, from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. At Oxley, you may park outside the gates from 7:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. to walk the trails even when the gates are closed.

At Redbud Valley Nature Preserve, the gates are open Wednesdays through Sundays, from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. You may **not** hop the fence when the Nature Preserve is closed: on Mondays or Tuesdays, on City holidays, before 8:00 a.m., or after 5:00 p.m.

Fundamentals of Nature Drawing

Gold, red, brown, and orange leaves glow with warmth on the hillsides at Redbud Valley each fall. Come learn to paint them in oils. Students will learn how to sketch with paints, lay down base colors, mix into colors, create the illusion of deta with a few strokes, and layer colors. We'll also discuss safe use and disposal of solvents and heavy-metal-based paints.



Preregistration is required for all classes. A supply list will be provided at that time. Fee must accompany registration.
