- 4. Continue the great work at Oxley and develop it even further,



#### Species Spotlight: Rough Green Snake Opheodrys aestivus

Even those of us who are *not* passionate about snakes can find a lot to love in this little arboreal snake. Maybe you've seen one or two at Oxley on a walk through wooded areas. You might have caught a flash of green and turned to see this graceful, slender creature slipping through the branches nearby. Usually around 32 inches long and under 1 inch in

diameter, this little snake is notable for it's relatively big eyes, bright green back and yellowish or cream colored stomach. The Rough Green Snake eats many types of insects including crickets, grasshoppers and caterpillars but is even known to eat small frogs. Stop and look next time you see one, it will often freeze in place and never fear, it is non-venomous!
