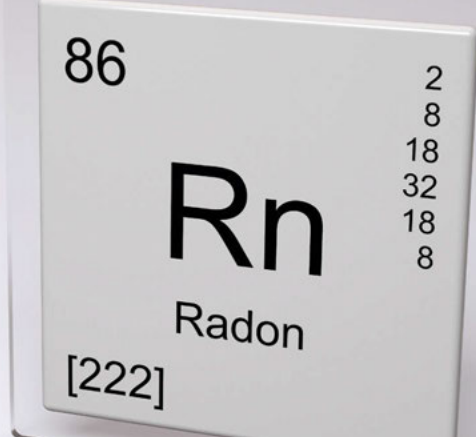


COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

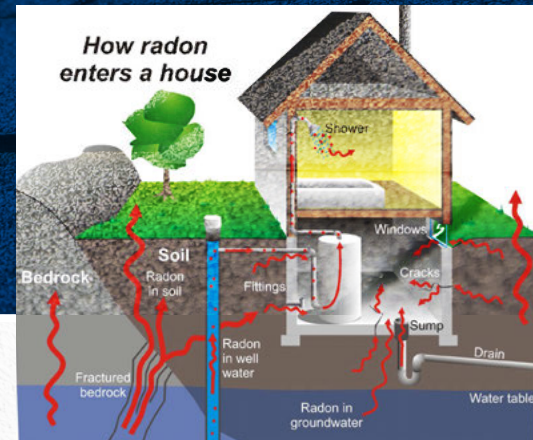

WHAT IS A PROCHECK RADON SYSTEM?

Our radon mitigation systems are professionally designed and installed by trained, licensed Radon Mitigation Specialists. Our specialists have passed a comprehensive National Radon Proficiency Program (NRPP) Radon Mitigation course and exam, must satisfy continuing education requirements, and are licensed by the State of Ohio Department of Health. ProCheck Radon Systems are installed according to the stringent requirements of the State of Ohio, Department of Health.

WHAT ITEMS ARE COVERED?

Upon entering the home, our Radon Mitigation Specialist will construct a schematic of the area in which a radon system could be installed, including the foundation walls, crawl space areas, locations of sump pumps, furnaces, hot water heaters, and any other items that may impact the installation and successful operation of a ProCheck Radon System. We welcome input from the client/home owner when options for the location of the radon system are available.

Locations of the radon systems are dictated by the most successful place to install the system to maximize radon reduction.

After the installation, our ProCheck Radon Mitigation Specialist will complete a comprehensive Post-Mitigation Checklist to ensure the job is up to Ohio Department of Health standards.

WHAT IS RADON?

Radon is a colorless, odorless, radioactive gas that comes from the soil. It is a gas that is a decay product of Uranium. Since it is radioactive, science has found ways to detect it using radiation detection machines (which ProCheck Radon systems owns!)

Since Radon is radioactive, it is unhealthy to humans and pets. It causes tissue damage and lung cancer when we are exposed to unhealthy levels.

RADON GETS IN THROUGH:

1. Cracks in solid floors.
2. Construction joints.
3. Cracks in walls.
4. Gaps in suspended floors.
5. Gaps around service pipes.
6. Cavities inside walls.

It is even in the air outside. But once it gets into the home, it concentrates into unhealthy levels.

It is estimated that exposure to radon causes 21,000 deaths per year, higher than deaths by drunk driving.

In the U.S., the EPA wants you to fix your home if the radon level is 4.0 pCi/liter of air, or higher. This is an amount of radon in a liter of air.

Radon levels less than 4.0 pCi/liter of air STILL POST A RISK and can often be reduced to even healthier levels with the installation of a ProCheck Radon System.

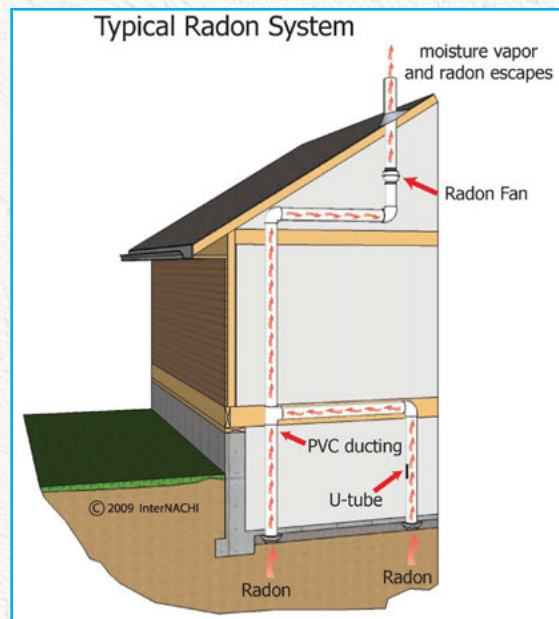
