RESOLUTION NO. 16-44

ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED COMMERCIAL VEHICLE AND TRUCK PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio met in regular session on the 7th day of June, at 7:00 p.m., at the Township Offices located at One Business Park Drive, with the following members present:

Trustee McGuire moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The ORC 505.17 provides that "the board of trustees may make regulations and orders as a necessary to control...all vehicle parking in the township; and

WHERAS, The ORC further provides that "all such regulations and orders shall be subject to the limitations, restrictions, and exceptions in sections 4511.01 to 4511.76 and 4513.02 to 4513.37; and

WHERAS, The Jefferson Township Board of Trustees had previously adopted Resolution 07-11 and 07-30 restricting truck and commercial vehicle parking in residential neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, The board of township trustees of Jefferson Township of Montgomery County, Ohio has determined the public safety and welfare would be served by restricting the parking of commercial vehicles and certain trucks on residential streets in the township.

WHEREAS, The regulation does not conflict with uniform traffic act, and is applicable only to unincorporated areas of the township

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

Section 1. The parking of commercial vehicles and vehicles weighing nine thousand (9,000) pounds or more on any residential street or ally in Jefferson Township is prohibited between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Section 2. For purposes of this resolution "commercial vehicle" shall have the same meaning a "commercial motor vehicle", defined in ORC 4506.01(D)1 through 4506.01(D)5.

Section 3. For purposes of this resolution "residential streets and ally" means any street or alley located in a zoning district zoned primarily for residential uses on the official Jefferson Township Zoning Map.

Section 4. Violations of this resolution shall be enforceable as provided in ORC 505.07

Section 5. The Township Administrator and the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to implement and enforce this resolution.

Section 7. This resolution supersedes and replaces Resolutions 07-11, Resolution 07-30, and any other resolution on this topic.
