Dr Maria Montessori was born in 1870. She was the first Female doctor in Italy. She studied Education, Philosophy, Psychology and Anthropology.



Montessori was pioneering in her child development theories, and designed materials and techniques which allowed the children to work in areas previously considered beyond their capacity. These materials and methods are used at Tall Trees Kindergarten to greatly enhance your child's opportunity to learn.

The Montessori Method is now recognised and highly regarded worldwide as one of the best learning environments for young children.
