The Concept

- 60 to 100 suites
- Commercial on the main floor (preferably Doctors office and Pharmacy)
- Residential suites floors 2-6
- Project cost \$13,000,000 to \$20,000,000 appraised value 6% cap rate
- Rental Rates \$300 per month more than market apartment

Example of Monthly Rental Suite

Bachelor	\$ 995	One bedroom	\$1495
Two Bedroom	\$1695	Three Bedroom	\$1895

- Life Style amenities with aging in place design (walker accessible)
- Total Staff 3 (General Manager, Leasing Rec Manager, Maintenance Manager)
- 24 hour emergency call program, recreation and on-site management and maintenance
- 12% circulation – 5% amenity space 83% efficiency
- 3500 sq. ft. of amenity space

New Model for Supportive Living

Albertans on average pay \$2500 per month to reside in a (ILSL)Independent Living/Supportive Living facility

We are proposing a new strategy to decrease the costs of supportive living, therefore attracting younger, more vibrant residents

This strategy includes an optional bistro restaurant that offers a limited daily menu

The proposed facility has less amenity space (3,500 sq. ft versus 10,000 sq. ft.)

Residents will pay for supportive services a la carte




