Sunday, July 24, 2016 The shuttle will leave the Newport Grand parking lot every hour on the half hour beginning at 9:30 am. The shuttle will make the last pick up at Newport Grand at 2:30 pm. Return trips from St. George's to the Newport Grand parking lot will run every hour on the hour beginning at 11:00 am. The shuttle will travel from St. George's to the Newport Grand lot for the last return run at 4:00 pm.
